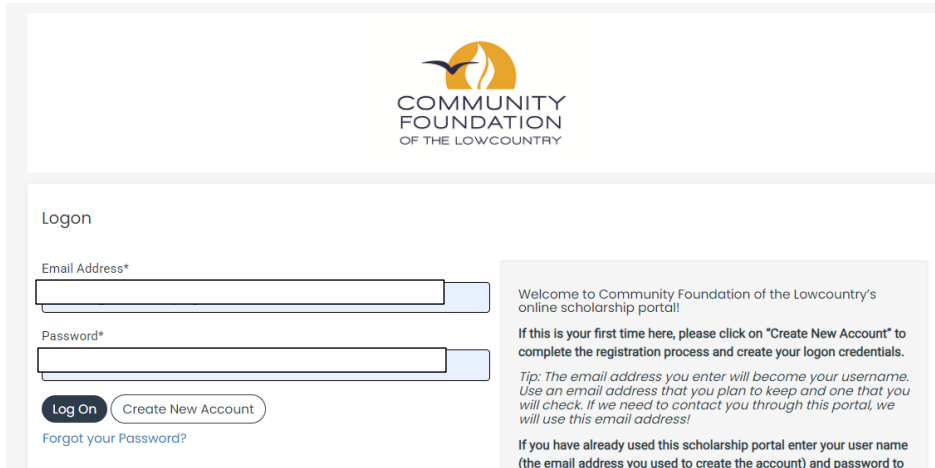




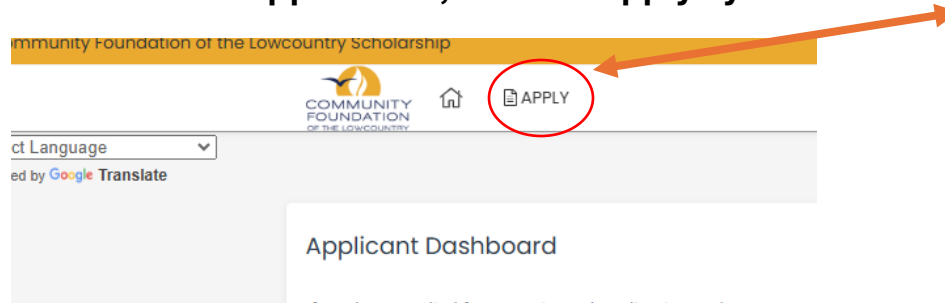
First Tee of the Lowcountry Scholarship Instructions:

You will need to access your existing account, or create a new account in Community Foundation of the Lowcountry's scholarship portal:

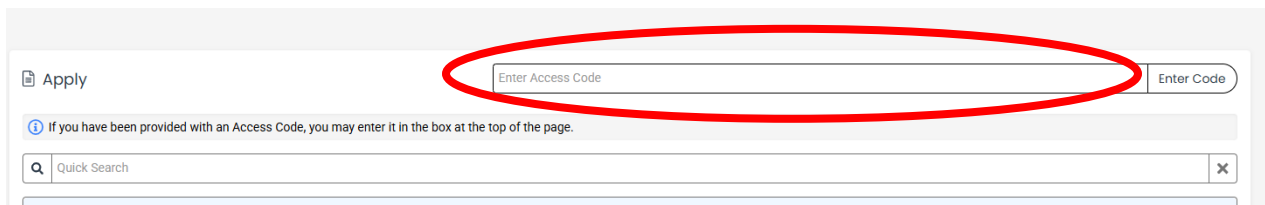
